

Introduction

We are a registered charity managed by a committee and run by professional and qualified staff. As a charity we do not make a profit from fees and hold regular fundraising events for new equipment.

Thanks to funding from the Lottery we were able to move from Sturry Social Centre into our new purpose built unit within the grounds of Sturry CE Primary School in February 2002.

Baby & Toddler Group

For all pre-school children from birth together with their parents/carers. A member of pre-school manages the session. Children remain the responsibility of their parents and carers at all times.

From 9.15am to 11.15am at Sturry Social Centre. Cost is £2.50 per family (price includes all craft, activities and refreshments). Your first visit is FREE!

Pre-School

We welcome visits to the setting but please telephone first to organise a suitable time. Our intakes are in September and January for children aged 2 years to school age.

There is a waiting list and it is advisable to get your child's name on the list as soon as possible. Waiting list forms are available from Baby & Toddler Group or direct from Pre-School (contact number on the back of this form).

Sessions are Monday, Wednesday and Friday's 9am – 11.30am and 12.30pm – 3pm with two special 'Sunflower' days for older children on Tuesdays and Thursday 9am – 2pm.

Current cost is £7.50 per session payable termly (approx 6-7 weeks) in advance. Your child is eligible for funded nursery education the accounting period (1 January, 1 April or 1 September following their third birthday).
